The Northgate development, along with other projects, is aimed to contribute to a reinvigorated city centre for Chester. The site, alongside the Town Hall and the proposed new Theatre, is reserved for new retail development, along with leisure uses and a new market.

The concept master plan that has been on view for consultation includes: a large department store plus 5 major store units, 51 shop units, 21 food and beverage units, a 924 space car park, and a relocated Market Hall with a multiplex cinema above.

Dave Anderson, Head of Planning Projects at Cheshire West and Chester Council is leading on this project. He has kindly agreed to meet members and update us on the current state of the proposals to redevelop this site. It will be a good opportunity to ask questions about the current concept master plan.
