



The Chester Civic Trust

Visit to KENT – 1st TO 6th October 2016

On Saturday 1st October, we will leave Chester for Kent, breaking our journey for lunch at Hertford to meet the Local Civic Society and take a tour of the town. We will then continue our journey south to Canterbury, which will be our base for the trip, staying at the Premier Inn in the centre of the City for dinner at the hotel. The following morning we will have a tour of Canterbury with members of Canterbury Civic Society and then break for lunch in the city. In early afternoon, we will then travel by coach to Chartwell to visit W S Churchill's former residence and then return to Canterbury for dinner at the hotel. Monday sees us travelling to the Chatham Historic Dockyard in the morning and then later going to Rochester for a tour with the Local Civic Society returning to Canterbury for dinner. We will arrange dinner that evening at a local restaurant.

On Tuesday, we will be at the seaside, visiting Ramsgate in the morning for a tour of the town and lunch; then afterwards going to Margate in the afternoon for a town tour with Margate Civic Society, taking in Turner Contemporary, a local gallery, to see some of his paintings. On Wednesday we visit Dover Castle in the morning and have lunch; then return to Canterbury where members can either stay in Canterbury at their own devices or visit a local winery. Finally, we return home on Thursday, having lunch in Tamworth followed by a guided walk around the town, before travelling back to Chester, arriving between 5 & 6pm.

The cost for this trip is £605 for single room occupancy and £ 1010 per couple. The cost will include all travel by coach, 5 nights half board at the hotel (except for one evening at a local restaurant which is also included); in addition, entry fees to Chatham Historic Dockyard, two lunches and all gratuities are covered.

Dover Castle is an English Heritage site so non-members of English Heritage would pay a supplement of £ £13 each as would those wishing to visit the Barnsole Winery pm on 5th October at a cost of £ 7.

We ask for a deposit of £60 per head by the end of July with the balance at the beginning of September.
